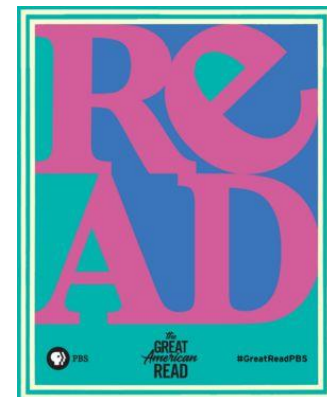

## Happy Starts for Little Ones

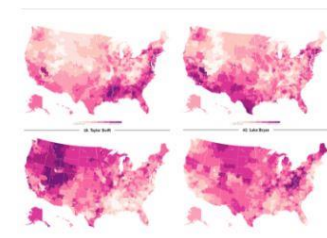
